

Information Sheet on School and Boarding Fees

Salem is a non-profit organisation. While subsidies from the government cover a certain portion of expenditures for tuition (as established in Baden-Württemberg's Private Schools Act), the school must meet all remaining expenditures through fees paid by parents.

The School and Boarding Fee (SBF) is the annual rate established for each school year by the School Management of Schule Schloss Salem gGmbH. Payment obligations for each school year continue through August 31 of each calendar year, independently of the summer holidays or date of graduation following Abitur or IB examinations.

The SBF is aligned with the actual expenses of a full school year. If several **siblings** attend Salem at the same time, the SBF of each sibling will be discounted by 10 %. **Children of Salem alumni** will be granted a 1,5 % discount. An **admission fee** which covers additional administrative costs is payable upon signing the School and Boarding Contract, if applicable an administration surcharge, along with a **security deposit** that will be refunded upon termination of the contract. For holders of scholarships granted by the school special arrangements may apply.

With regard to the SBF Salem is committed to providing those services outlined in No. V. of the General Terms and Conditions of contract (GTC). The incidental expenses enumerated in No. VII. of the GTC will be billed separately.
